Problem

The problem we have chosen to work on is the lack of recreational facilities in the City of Aurora.

Goal

Our goal is to have more recreational space available to the residents of Aurora Colorado. In order to meet this goal, funds would have to be raised. We would like to see a ballot initiative in the election year 2010. On the November ballots in 2010, we would like for the residents in Aurora to be able to vote for either increasing sales tax or homeowners' taxes so that the necessary funds can be raised. - How do we get an initiative on the ballot? How does the process work?
